

## \*Attention macOS 10.15 Catalina users\*


Please disable **System Integrity Protection (SIP)** before installing the XQD driver for Mac.

### DISABLE SIP


1. Restart your Mac.
2. Immediately hold down **Command+R** on your keyboard to boot into the macOS Recovery.
3. When you see the **macOS Utilities** windows, select **Terminal** from the **Utilities** menu.




4. Type **csrutil disable** and press Return.



5. Close the **Terminal** app.




6. From the **Apple menu**, select **Restart**.



7. Install the XQD driver.

8. During the XQD driver installation, you might encounter a pop-up window stating “**System Extension Blocked**”. Instead of clicking on “OK”, “**Open Security Preferences**” and “**Allow**” system software from “**Sony Corporation**” to load.



## **ENABLE SIP**

1. Restart your Mac.
2. Immediately hold down **Command+R** on your keyboard.
3. Select **Terminal** from the **Utilities** menu.
4. Type **csrutil enable** and press Return.
5. Close the Terminal app.
6. From the **Apple menu**, select **Restart**.
